New power carts

Hidden Valley revamped its fleet of carts, switching to brand-new EZ-GO 48-volt electric carts that are direct from the factory and ready to take you to your golf ball.

The new carts have increased safety features, have the power to get up inclines and are geared back for going down the hilly slopes. No parking brake is ever needed, so you won't have to worry about forgetting to lock it in before you get out.

Trees downed

Hidden Valley was hit hard last summer by a disease that affected a majority of the older trees throughout the 375 acres that make up our course. Over the winter, the Hidden Valley maintenance staff cut down the affected and dead trees, cleaning up the course and increasing sight lines on several holes.
